6. Events

Entries to the All British Race Meeting are open to all makes of British Vehicles and invited vehicles. Events will be held for both Racing and Regularity categories. The format and events for the meeting will be determined once entries close. Please provide as much information as possible on the entry form to help organise categories. All race categories will receive 1 x 10 minute qualifying session. It is anticipated that race competitors will receive 3 or 4 races of 5 to 8 laps duration. Regularity competitors will receive 1 x 10 minute practice session and a minimum of 2 x 15 minute regularity events.

7. Licence Requirements

- a. Racing - Competitors must hold a minimum AASA Level 2 licence or equivalent.
- b. Regularity – Competitors must hold a HSRCA Regularity, AASA Level 2 or General Competition licence.

8. Safety Requirements

- a. Any vehicle which holds a log book or vehicle passport must supply this to scrutineering with the vehicle.
- b. Any vehicle competing in the Racing Categories must be fitted with approved roll over protection and must wear approved clothing as per standard racing requirements.
- c. Competitors in Regularity Category do not require roll over protection. All drivers must wear helmets, apparel and harness as per current accepted requirements for the event entered. Fire resistant clothing is not mandatory, but drivers must wear a minimum of woollen or cotton clothing covering the body from ankle to wrist and neck (Synthetic materials are not permitted) and suitable and appropriate footwear. Goggles/visors must be worn at all times by the driver of open cars. These articles must be submitted for approval with the car at scrutineering.
- d. A limited number of race suits and helmets are available for hire from the circuit.

9. Automatic Timing

The organisers utilise an automatic timing system, which requires all race cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter, which is the competitor's responsibility. Data 1 transmitter are available for purchase or hire from Eldee Timing – 0402 830 313.

11. Passes

All passes will be mailed out with acceptance of entry.

Each Driver will be allocated four (4) Competitor Admission Passes for the meeting. The competitor admission passes are the identification required for access to the marshalling area and signalling areas. There will be no refunds for persons having to pay at the gate. Additional Passes can be ordered at a discounted rate of \$10 (GST inc), in the space provided on the Entry Form.
